

Levine Children's Hospital Workshop Art Project

Hodges Taylor Gallery and Community School of the Arts partnered in 2006 on behalf of the new Levine Children's Hospital to coordinate and select artwork for the hospital. Shug Lockett was chosen as one of several teaching artists to design and conduct a workshop to create artwork with local school students some of which would be chosen to exhibit in the new hospital.

Shug worked with high school students at East Mecklenburg High School teaching them the basics of stained tissue collage. Each student made a small collage on panel incorporating leaf imagery created by stamping and lasertran transfer techniques. These images combine to create larger artworks and were chosen to be displayed in the Levine Children's Hospital.
